<b>Vocabulary:</b> <b>Country:</b> an area of land that has its own government <b>Continent:</b> a large land mass, typically a group of countries. <b>Ocean:</b> a very large expanse of water. <b>Sea:</b> smaller than oceans and usually located where the land and ocean meets.		<b>Images:</b>
