Great Explorers

PSHE

In PSHE, through the unit 'Managing Change', the children will understand that there are changes they can manage themselves and changes they can't do anything about. They will know that change is a part of everyday life. They will recognise that they are growing, and their achievements, skills and responsibilities are changing. They will say some feelings they might have at times of change, suggest things they might do to cope with those changes or share strategies.

RE

This term we learn about special books like the Bible in Christianity and the Qur'an in Islam, We listen to the story of Moses and Jonah and the whale from the Bible, and The Crying Camel from the Qur'an.



Forest School

This term in our weekly Forest School sessions we will explore signs of summer when learning about the different seasons and share what we know in different ways. As always, we will encourage active play in Forest School with a range of songs and games, linked to nature and weather. We will create environmental and natural art inspired by Andy Goldsworthy. Phonics

Through our daily phonics lessons we will learn to:

- Read and write words containing the suffix -less, ful, -er, -ly, -y, -ment, -est, ful and -ness.
- Revisit apostrophes in their contracted and possessive form.
- Read and spell all the year 2 common exception words correctly.

KS1 Assessments

Throughout the Summer term we will continue to do our own in school assessments. The children will not be doing KS1 assessments [also referred to as Year 2 SATs].

Some children will be required to take the Year 2 phonics recheck if they did not pass in Year 1. This will take place the WB 9th June.

Homework

Homework will be sent home each week via a homework book and consist of phonics, spelling and/or maths challenges. It will be sent out each Friday and needs to be completed by the following Wednesday. Please support and encourage your child when they are doing their homework, although it should primarily be their own work. All work will be checked by the class teacher and stamped with an Aim High Hippo. Your child would also significantly benefit from daily reading with you using the book sent home in their bookbag and/or **Bug Club** to reinforce the phonics and reading skills they are learning in school.
