Preschool children have been digging for worms and using new vocabulary like 'wiggly', 'squirm' and 'wormery' all linked to the book, 'Superworm'. Year R/Etoc R

This week in **Class 1** and **2** we have been enjoying some computing! We have experimented with creating an audio recording on a iPad and have had a go at programming using 2Go. In literacy we have been learning to write a simple sentence, beginning it with a capital letter and ending with a full stop. Maths learning has focused on noticing and continuing patterns within numbers to 10, including odd and even numbers, double facts and how quantities can be shared equally.

Next week, in our enquiry sessions we will be learning about the sculptor Antony Gormley and using clay to experiment with a range of techniques, including coiling.

Year 1/Etoc 1

Class 3 and Class 4 have had another busy week with lots of Involved Iguanas. We have enjoyed programming the Bee-Bots in computing and even predicting and testing which surfaces they move better on when programmed. In English we have been planning our alternative version to 'Jack and the Beanstalk', and have made our own changes, ready to write our own version. Maybe your child could use simple sentences and story language to tell you their own version. In maths we have been learning about place value, by partitioning two digit numbers into tens and ones.

Next week we will be comparing and ordering numbers. In enquiry we will be looking at Antony Gormley particularly his sculptures, for art and design.

Year 2/Etos 2

Class 5 and 6 have been acting out a new version of 'The Runaway Chapati' in **English** with actions to their classmates. Ask the children to show you their version, they are good! In **maths** they have worked on a medley of addition and subtraction work. The afternoons have been jam packed with the children using the i-pads to video themselves in computing, sharing facts about the Wright Brothers and programming a Bee-Bot.

Next week, the children are going to start investigating the work of the artist Antony Gormley. They will plan their writing for their own version of the crafty chapati in English and in maths they will be solving addition and subtraction problems.
